Please make sure that you are ready and waiting for your transportation to arrive!



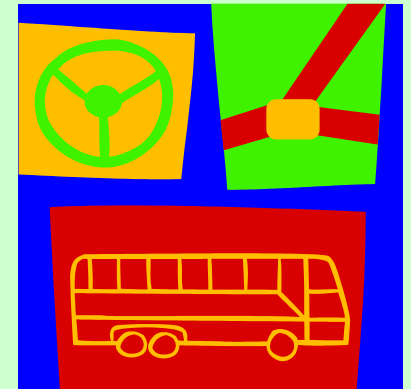

Safety Tips



- Wait for exiting passengers to leave, then board the bus.
- Please have the exact fare ready to place in the fare box. The box is located next to the driver. The driver cannot give change.
- Directly behind the bus driver, there are some seats designated for senior citizens and people with disabilities. You may be asked to find another seat if they are needed.
- Customers with visual impairments might not be able to identify their bus stop, and will have to ask for their stop to be announced. The passenger may request the bus driver to announce the stop at the time that he/she boards the bus.

- If you must stand, please move as far to the back of the bus as possible. It is not permitted for a passenger to stand or sit in the door stairwells.



- For the safety and comfort of everyone, playing music on any device without earphones; smoking; and animals (except service animals) are not permitted on any vehicle.
- Use the handrails provided to help you climb up and down the steps.

- Wait on the sidewalk away from the curb, not in or near the street.
- Be ready to exit when you arrive at your stop. You must wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before trying to exit the bus. Step away after exiting. Do not walk directly in front of the bus after exiting
- Dress appropriately for weather conditions.
- Watch your step, especially at night or in wet weather.
